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This cowl is knit in the round using the Linen Stitch. Using this stitch has been on my wish list for years. Why? Because I started out as a weaver and this stitch not only appears to be woven but it is also knit as an “over/under” pattern. By knitting in the round, you never have to purl. It is merely a knit stitch and a slipped stitch, over and over again. Because an odd number of stitches is cast on, you can continue to go round and round. I really got into a rhythm and it became a meditative kind of process. You can use a kit made of Zephyrette or you can use leftovers. I would just caution you to use the same weight of yarn in your leftovers.

Finished Measurements:

Unblocked: 21” diameter 8” long

Blocked: 23” diameter 8.25” long

Materials and Notions:

1 skeins/2 oz/~ 220 yards of Zephyrette

Main color: Jade (100 yards)

C1: Creamsicle (25 yards)

C2: Lavender Fields (25 yards)

C3: Avocado (25 yards)

C4: Jewel Tones (25 yards)

Tapestry needle

Stitch marker

Size US 6 (4mm) circular needle

Abbreviations:

K1: knit one

S1: slip stitch as if to purl

Cast on 161 stitches (or more if you want a wider cowl)
Join the round being careful to not twist the stitches.
Mark beginning of round with a stitch marker
Knit one round

Pattern Stitch: Linen Stitch

K1, S1 repeat

Colorwork borders:

Work in pattern with following colors

Main color (MC): 2 rounds

Color 1 (C1): 2 rounds

Color 2 (C2): 2 rounds

Color 3 (C3): 2 rounds

Repeat in order 4 times

C1: 2 rounds

C3: 2 rounds

MC: 2 rounds

Repeat these 2 colors 3 times

Color 4 (C4): 2 rounds

C3: 2 rounds

Repeat these 2 colors 2 times

MC: 2 rounds

C3: 2 rounds

MC: 2 rounds

C3: 2 rounds

Body:

MC: continue for 3-3.5 inches (this area
can be expanded)

Now we will work the border backwards.

C₃: 2 rounds

MC: 2 rounds

Color 4 (C₄): 2 rounds

C₃: 2 rounds

Repeat these 2 colors 2 times

C₃: 2 rounds

MC: 2 rounds

Repeat these 2 colors 3 times

C₁: 2 rounds

Main color (MC): 2 rounds

Color 1 (C₁): 2 rounds

Color 2 (C₂): 2 rounds

Color 3 (C₃): 2 rounds

Repeat in order 4 times

Knit one round in MC

Bind off loosely

Block

Weave in ends.
