


Craft Activism Resources


<u>Craft Activism</u> is a lovely book. There are several ideas of projects that you and your like minded friends can accomplish.




<u>Crafting the Resistance</u> This book has a feminist bent and 23 projects for you to make from pussy hats to a Nag Bag. So fun!!






<u>How to be a Craftivist</u> shows us how to develop a gentle, respectful protest through craft with respect and optimism.
